Qëllimi i këtij studimi është të hartojë një analizë krahasuese midis Kosovës dhe Shqipërisë në lidhje me ekzistencën e dispozitave për mbrojtjen e të drejtave të njeriut të përcaktuara në kodet përkatëse penale të të dy

vendeve. Kosova ka bërë një rrugë të gjatë në krijimin e legjislacionit të saj, veçanërisht në sistemin e drejtësisë penale. Është punuar në harmonizimin e legjislacionit me atë të Bashkimit Evropian dhe më pas ka për qëllim arritjen e harmonizimit të tij. Këto janë parakushte ligjore në rrugën e integritimit evropian që vendi ynë duhet patjetër të ndjekë. Në vitin 2012 u miratua Kodi Penal, i cili hyri në fuqi më 1 janar 2013 dhe gjithashtu punonte në Kodin e Procedurës Penale. Kështu, është themeluar baza ligjore për drejtësinë penale. Legjislacioni i ri penal parashikon shumë institucione të reja, inkriminime të reja, dënime të politikës ndëshkuese dhe inovacione të tjera. Nga ana tjetër, Shqipëria gjithashtu përballet me një shkëlqje të drejtave të njeriut. Megjithatë janë miratuar shumë dispozita ligjore, akte ndërkombëtare janë ratifikuar, ende ekzistojnë shumë probleme, mangësi dhe nevoja në këtë sektor. Megjithatë arritjet e mësipërme, ende ka shumë shkëlqje të drejtave të njeriut, të cilat në shumicën e
